

Product Recall Notice

Hipod iFold Strollers made before July 2013.



Defect: A consumer's finger may become caught in the stroller hinge while the stroller is being folded.

Hazard: This presents a finger laceration hazard to consumers folding the stroller.

In the United States there have been a very small number of incidents where parents have reported finger injuries when folding the Britax B-Agile 3 stroller and in 4 instances medical attention was required. As a result the stroller has been subject to recall action in USA and Canada. The above listed strollers sold in Australia by Britax Childcare have a similar frame construction and Britax Childcare is offering free *Hinge Cover Kits* to owners.

Even though there were very few reported incidents in USA and no injuries reported in Australia, Britax Childcare has decided to offer free *Hinge Cover Kits* for the above strollers which consumers can fit by themselves. The Hipod iFold strollers were sold through Target stores around Australia. *Free Hinge Cover Kits* are being offered to owners and can be easily installed by users at home.

If you are affected, you may continue to use the stroller but when folding press the release the button and then pull the release strap at the center of the seat with the same hand to avoid any risk of injury. Importantly, keep your fingers clear of the hinge when folding. See the video on how to fold safely at <http://goo.gl/KcoiS6>

Model & Batch label showing the batch number as a year and month are attached to the rear leg of the stroller. Batches 13 06 (June 2013) or earlier are affected.
